\$250,000 spent on full interior and exterior heritage restoration including repairs to windows, repointing masonry, new flooring inside, flood lighting and CCTV as well as new electrical and lighting.





\$600,000 spent on full fabric restoration of gates to make them operable again.





\$350,000 spent on interior and exterior heritage restoration including repairs to roof, gutters, balcony balustrade and hardwood floors and new kitchen.





\$590,000 spent renovating inside and out to prepare Building 497 for future use as a community and sports facility. Additional \$600,000 to be spent bringing building up to building code and accessibility requirements.
